Continuance of the August 18 meeting was called to order at 4:32 p.m. with Commission members Minnaert, McCarty present and Drengwitz on conference call. Others present were Bob Karls, Chief Woolford and Chief Runyon.

Fire Report continued:

Since we met on the 18th, candidate Josh Easton has completed his Psychological exam, CPAT and Physical exam at OSF St. James hospital.

On a phone call from Tom Campion of Campion and Borrow, it was reported that Josh Easton was qualified for the position of Fire Fighter with the Pontiac Fire Department. Josh passed the CPAT exam with some time remaining. The Occupational Health department nurse called and gave a report of being healthy.

A recommendation was made by Chief Runyon to hire Josh Easton. Motion was made by McCarty, second by Drengwitz. Motion carried unanimously.

Police Report continued:

Chief Woolford gave an update on the remaining eligibility list. Chief Woolford has started obtaining releases to start background checks on the next three potential candidates on the list. He stated that since he was granted permission to explore available dates to begin testing at the last meeting, he has not had time to start the inquiry with COPS testing.

With no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by McCarty, second by Drengwitz. Meeting was adjourned at 4:47 p.m.
