Notice is hereby given that the City of Pontiac Planning and Zoning Board will hold a meeting on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers to consider the following:

Timothy and Patricia Fogarty, petitioners, have requested that a portion of West Washington Avenue and West Lincoln Avenue be vacated and ownership of same be deeded over to the Petitioners and/or adjoining landowner, the City of Pontiac, IL. The properties in question are:

TRACT 1:

Lots 1 and 2 in Block 1 in Haynes and John's Addition to Pontiac, Livingston County, Illinois, EXCEPT a strip of land :beginning at the Northwest Corner of said Lot 2, thence East 113.66 feet along the North lines of said Lots 2 and 1, thence Southeasterly along a curve of radius 474.36 feet (said curve being concave to the Northwest) to a point on the West line of said Lot 2, said point being 39.9 feet North of the Southwest Corner thereof, thence North to the Point of Beginning, all contained in Lots 1 and 2 in Block 1 in Haynes and John's Addition to the City of Pontiac, Livingston County, Illinois. TRACT 2:
