Budget - FY 21-22 - Discussion

Bob Karls presented to Committee information on past and projected figures for the General Fund revenues. Those paid by all, such as sales tax; revenues paid by Pontiac only residents, such as real estate taxes, cable tv and licenses; and state revenues, as in Income Tax. Also discussed were the proposed TIF projects to be decided on and or completed.

Vermillion Plaza owners are hoping to have some new occupants. Block 59 is going to be very much marketed and should have a lot of activity starting this spring/summer.

In the next 6-weeks, there will be more meetings for discussion on the budget, with each department head presenting their plans and hopeful projects.

It was decided, for now, that City Council meetings and Committee Meetings of the Whole will be held at the Eagle Theater. Staff is looking into equipment to live stream the meetings.
