

MINUTES OF THE PONTIAC CITY COUNCIL
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
February 8, 2021

The Committee of the Whole meeting of the Pontiac City Council was held on Monday, February 8, 2021 at the Eagle Theater, Pontiac.

Mayor Alvey called to order the meeting at 6:00 P.M.

The City Clerk was directed to call roll, and the following members of the Council were present: Barr, Giovanini, Causer, Bradshaw, Myers, Gabor and Wille.

Budget - FY 21-22 - Discussion

Jim Melvin, Cemetery Superintendent, told Council that there were 37 burials in 2020. Projects to be worked on this year is the expansion of the cemetery after the house on Locust Street is torn down; removal of some dead trees; and work on the roads in the cemetery. Also plans to replace the flower boxes on Mill Street Bridge and continue with the program asking any merchant downtown to continue water the planters in front of businesses.

Jake Kinkade, Wastewater Treatment Department Superintendent announced to Council that the Sewer project is 40% completed and projected to finish fall of 2022. Also department is working on the combined sewer overflows, Elliotts and Westview Subdivision and Southside separators. Brian Verdun, City Engineer explained the upcoming projects including the sewer project at the Rec Plex.

Chris Brock, Street Department Superintendent noted that because of COVID, the department was able to complete more projects that were not associated with contact with residents. One of the many projects that was completed was the Ice Rink. Plans for the 2021 year include work at the airport, the Fell Park Band Shell, Play Park road and Chautauqua Park road, work on two City Building roofs and continue tree removal and planting.

Continued discussion on the revenues and costs for each department.
