Budget - 2022-2023 Discussion

Chris Brock presented to Council the work that was done by the Streets Department in 2021 on a regular basis, projects, as in the Riverside Parks Restrooms, sidewalks, airport stripes, outdoor dining set up and golf course work. Also discussed was COVID absences, parts supply shortage and price increases. Projects planned for 2022. City owned house demolitions, event season, finalizing a plan to stop burning at City garage, possible new "fuel island" for city vehicles, Mill Street Bridge sidewalk repair and the turkey vulture problem.

Bob Karls also continued the discussion on revenues and expenses, such as salaries for police, fire and teamsters, projection on sales tax revenues, possible TIF extension, facade grant program and Rural Fire District contract.
