

MINUTES OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE
October 14, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman Gabor. The following members present: Gabor, Wille, Myers, Causer, Barr, and Eckhoff.

The following items were discussed:

1. Outdoor Dining - The Committee discussed the past several months of temporary arrangements for outdoor dining. They reviewed the requirements for beer gardens. They recommended that as long as capacity is limited that the requirements, perjured for beer gardens be waived and temporary plans be approved by the Mayor acting as Liquor Commissioner. They also intend to review the beer garden requirements be revisited based upon an evaluation of this year and next year's experience. Committee also recommended staff look at CBD seating in light of the Madison Street project.
2. Bike Path Grant - The Committee reviewed the bike grant application and recommended approval and the use of TIF Funds for the necessary match.
3. 2021-2022 Budget - The Committee reviewed the Street projects for the previous year that were tabled, and placed thru as priority for the coming year.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
