- Former Site of the 1872 Livingston County Jail
- Design / Farnsworth Group
- General Contractor / Vissering Construction

SITE

- 7100 s.f. of concrete paving
- Stone seats are from the former jails exterior walls
- (2) 15' x 15' shade structures
- IDPH required fencing for separation between playground and splash pad

PLAYGROUND

- 5-12 yr. old ADA Playground
- Features
 - ✓ (2) 12' Spiral Slides
 - ✓ 12' Tower
 - ✓ Rumble Slide
 - ✓ Wilder Slide
 - ✓ Little Foot Slide
 - ✓ Sensory Wave Arch
 - ✓ ADA Ramp and guard rails
- Poured-in-Place Safety Surfacing w/underdrains

SPLASH PAD

- 4300 s.f. splash pad with colored sand finish concrete for better traction
- Liquid chlorine recirculation system
- Max. flow / 457.5 gpm
- Control system include water & lights
- (15) Above ground water features
- (19) In-ground features

RESTROOM STORAGE BUILDING

- Styled after the existing swing bridges
- Separation of men's and women's restrooms for safety
- Areas left to add Murals per part of the downtown mural program
- Pump control room for splash pad
- Electrical service panels & storage
